This Partnership Agreement (the "Agreement") is made and entered into this day of the submission of this form (the "Effective Date"). The Partners in this Agreement are as follows:

The Partners to this Agreement agree to the following:

I. NAME: This Partnership will be known as "WhereWeAllMeet Venue Partnership" (the "Partnership").

II. THE PARTNERSHIP

- The Partners wish to become legal partners in business.
- The terms and conditions of their Partnership will be outlined in this Agreement.
- If the Agreement is executed, the Partnership will be in effect on the date of this form submission.
- The Partnership will only be terminated as outlined in this Agreement.
- The Partnership's primary place of business will be the address listed on this form
- The Partnership will be governed under blue sky law and the laws and statues of Nevada.
- The Partnership's primary purpose is to cross promote and scale business for our venue partners
- If applicable, the Partners will provide a discount or offer to WWAM members
- Allow API connection or branded page from WWAM app for a seamless member booking experience

III. CONTRIBUTIONS

Partners are willing to provide space to allocate printed materials, access to any A/V screens, sharing details on website and social media, system API/branded WWAM page for seamless pass through bookings and other as indicated below: **Please use the notes section or the appropriate field on the form to fill in this information.**

Options to create on-site API/inApp booking/branded page:

- A. Events, reservations, tickets, etc. can be booked via API (Application Programming Interface) to your systems payment page. We DO ALL OF THE WORK. We will provide system documentation for approval.
- B. We build a landing page that attaches to your current system so we know how many customers we are sending and which members are booking.
- C. We create a page on your current site with a #WWAM logo on it and link to that specific page.
- D. We create a form utilizing GET-POST method (GET method is used to request data from a specified resource. POST request, provides additional data from the client to the server message body) to make this an effective integration. This requires No Work on your part.
- E. If you use a 3rd party reservation system or plugin, we would create a page that works with ANY system so there is no barrier to us sending you customers.
- F. Your Team, Software/IT Dept. or Marketing Department create a page on your site with the WhereWeAllMeet.com logo affixed that remains on your server. We create a direct link to that payment or reservation page and the patron transacts right there. Just send us the link. Your new customers await.

IV. COSTS

There is no cost to the venue. Although members are booking through the API/branded page, WhereWeAllMeet.com will not be taking any monies or profits from the venue or any reservations or ticket sales.

V. PROFITS

All profits outside of WWAM discount member benefits are attributed to the venue. WWAM does not require any Venue profits.

VI. PARTNER ROLES

WWAM Roles:

- List events according to Venue's schedule and promote to our members
- Co-sponsor events with Venue
- Provide WWAM giveaways if applicable
- Promote and host WWAM sponsored events upon Venue approval
- Build and manage API/branded page for seamless booking
- Blog and showcase Venue stories on social channels, etc. according to Venue's marketing plan
- Section/Venue buyouts to showcase Venue to new members

Venue Roles:

- Provide accurate schedule of events and hours of operation
- Provide venue experience consistent with Venue's branding guidelines
- Work with WWAM staff to facilitate smooth entrance to Venue with security/door person/other
- Provide optimal time for WWAM event setup
- Provide logos and branding for the Venue itself and every event on location with WWAMBassador
- Keep WWAM up-to-date with menu, hours or other changes at Venue so that WWAM can communicate effectively with members
- Provide point of contact for WWAMBassador at Venue location

VII. ACCOUNTING

A. Venue is responsible for their own accounting as is WWAM.

B. WWAM will keep a record of the monthly analytics for WWAM members at Venue and will make the report available upon request to the Venue.

VIII. WITHDRAWAL

Either Partner hereby reserves the right to withdraw from the Partnership at any time.

IX. IDEMNIFICATION AND LIABILITY

Should the Partnership be dissolved, the Partnership will be void. WWAM assumes no responsibility of any debt from the Venue and vice versa. Additionally,

- WWAM will be held harmless for any damages or events during the normal parameters of the Venue's business.
- WWAM operates solely as a promotional arm for the Venue.
- Venue is responsible for safety and security of the Venue, unless required by Venue or law for a WWAM private event.
- Venue is responsible for maintaining presentation of the Venue, aligned with brand identity of the Venue outside of any cleanup derived from WWAM decorations or promotional fanfare.
- Venue indemnifies WWAM for any violent acts that causes harm to a patron at any event.
- WWAM is not responsible for food or drinks or resulting effects of food or drinks.
- Venue is responsible for maintaining all operational licenses and insurance as required by law.
- WWAM does not share any personal identifiable information outside of the venue.

X. DISPUTE RESOLUTION

The parties will attempt to resolve any dispute arising out of or relating to the Partnership or this Agreement through friendly negotiations amongst the parties. If the matter is not resolved by negotiation, the parties will resolve the dispute using the below Alternative Dispute Resolution (ADR) procedure. The ADR will be submitted to mediation in accordance with any statutory rules of mediation in the state of Nevada. If mediation is not successful in resolving the entire dispute or is unavailable, any outstanding issues will be submitted to final and binding arbitration under the rules of the American Arbitration Association. The arbitrator's award will be final, and judgment may be entered upon it by any court having proper jurisdiction within the state of Nevada
